EXPERIENCE

- Journeyperson crane operators with Class 1 (preferred) or Class 3 (accepted) licenses that can operate All-Terrain vehicles up to 500 tonnes.
- 100 tonne to 500 tonne All-Terrain Cranes
- To drive a mobile crane weighing between 3.5 and 7.5 tonnes a Category C1 Driving Licence is required and a Category C Licence if the crane is over 7.5 tonnes.
